FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

When John Wesley met with his parish every week, he would ask them: *How is it with your soul?* He knew that even Jesus managed to find time to be alone in prayer, especially during those times that were most trying. Remember? Before he was led away to the cross to die, he made time in his day to pray, to listen for God's will and ask for the strength to carry it out.

So I wonder. Why do so many of us live as though we think we can do it all, live in Christ-like obedience without really making time for God's Holy Spirit to refresh and restore us?

Only when we are filled with *ruach* are we truly able to follow.

So I ask you: How is it with **your** soul? Where in your life do you allow God to have your full, undivided attention (as nearly as you are able)?

Some of you have told me how grateful you are for Bluetooth, because now you can drive and pray out loud to God—and no one thinks you're weird. They just assume you are on a call. (It's true-- you are. Unashamedly so.)

Prayer is the wellspring from which we draw all strength. The one who cannot pray, or who is only comfortable repeating the prayers of others, is missing out on a deeper spiritual connection. God is inviting you to experience so much more.

Resurrection Sunday is upon us. Let your heart be open to the Love and Joy God has in store for you, personally tailored to fit your life and your needs. Let your dry, thirsty spiritual bones receive new life.
