## A gem with many facets

As you probably know, I have spent the past week out in Colorado with my family as we celebrate my mother's wonderful life of nearly a hundred years. It was, of course, a time of sadness—but there was also laughter and joy.

One of the "fun" things about funerals is learning how other people saw the person who died. I remember the service of the matriarch of a former church, where the stories of silliness were so completely *not* in keeping with the woman I knew, I began to wonder if I was at the wrong funeral!

My mother's pastor saw my parents as thoughtful, faithfilled Christians willing to put their money where their mouths were.

Her church friends remember her for her silly socks. Mom had over fifty pairs of fancy, silly and celebratory socks, from minions and monkeys to jack-o-lanterns and jumping kangaroos. What an expression of who she was!

Each of us kids remembers her a little differently, of course. By the time I came along (Number Four of Five), she had mellowed a bit. (Unlike Alice, I *never* received the spankings I am fairly sure I may have deserved!) And of course, we *all* agree that my little brother Jim was spoiled rotten. . . .

Now, under the loving gaze of the One who created her, my mother Muriel is seen, as we all are, as perfect. Wholly loved by God. The amazing thing about God is this: No matter what we might have done or think we have done (or should have done), God's Love is unshakeable. God forged us out of ordinary mud, and from that mud emerged individually perfect reflections of different facets of God.

You are perfect. You are necessary. And above all, you are loved beyond measure.


