Let it go, let it go! Turn away and slam the door!*

The staff of the Berea City School District aims to provide specialized instruction in the area of behavior in order to empower their students with the skills needed to meet with success in future placements.

The staff strives to create a safe and positive school environment that looks at each student as a unique individual. J&G Snow School is committed to helping all students succeed in the classroom both behaviorally and academically.

OHIOGUIDESTONE

OhioGuidestone is a faith-based agency that provides a range of mental health and substance use disorder services for children and adults.

OhioGuidestone and the Berea City School District work together at Snow School. OhioGuidestone decides which children enter Snow School and what therapies each child needs, or whether their needs could be better met somewhere else.
