Start by doing what's necessary; then do what's possible; and suddenly, you are doing the impossible. -St. Francis of Assisi

Half-baked?

The loaf of banana bread was decidedly gummy inside, and definitely could have used another five (or more) minutes in the oven. And even the project I thought I was wrapping up turned out the have an extra corner of stitching I hadn't yet completed. Yikes!

All these silly observations got me to wondering. What areas in my spiritual life could benefit from a little closer attention, a longer period of engagement? Or-where in my life might I be well-served by pulling back and doing less?

How long, for instance, should I spend reading my Bible? I try to spend some time each day, but sometimes . . . when I get bogged down in parts I simply don't like . . . I find myself turning away for a bit. And I think that's okay. God's Presence extends far, far beyond the pages on my NIV. We will find each other elsewhere.

You probably know, I love to walk. What about my life would be improved if I dedicated myself to walking even one hundred steps further than I had planned? But-when my back is tired, or the day is cold and windy, less becomes more. Taking it easy and being gentle with myself are healthy, vital practices.

Jesus reminds us that we are salt and light (Matthew 5:13-14). A dash of salt brings out the flavors of other things; too much salt can spoil a whole pot of stew, making it inedible to many hungry souls. A single candle in the darkness can help us find our way; barreling in with a 500-watt spotlight can literally be blinding and unbearable.

As we draw near the manger one more time, remember: there is a baby sleeping there! Approach with eyes wide with wonder and curiosity-but be soft and gentle in all you do. Shhhhhh. . . .

I am grateful we are on this journey together.


