### A NOTE ABOUT THIS MORNING'S MUSIC

Today, our featured composer is **Scott Joplin** (1868-1917). He was an American composer and pianist. Best known as the King of Ragtime and for his song "The Entertainer," (used in the 1973 movie The Sting which won an Oscar for Best Film Score), he wrote many famous pieces including the "Maple Leaf Rag," "the Gladiolus Rag," and the opera *Treemonisha*. Joplin's music



continues to inspire other musicians and composers more than a century after his death.
