

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

One of my favorite traditions at Strongsville United Church of Christ is that we come together every month to share in Holy Communion. Different traditions often do things a little differently. Having been raised United Methodist and mentored in other denominations, as well, let me explain the "why" behind some of the things I do.

You may have noticed, for instance, that the person holding the loaf will break off a chunk of bread and offer it to you, rather than offering you the loaf to pull off a chunk for yourself. The server offers you the bread because Christ offered himself in sacrifice for you; it is up to you to accept the offering Christ made. The gift of God's grace is always available, but God will never force us to accept something in which we have no interest. (The other, practical reason for doing this is simply a health issue. The fewer hands touching the loaf, the better. The servers have sanitized their hands before serving. We want you to stay healthy.)

Ever wonder why we use grape juice instead of wine? Even though the United Church of Christ has no policy opposing the use of wine, offering grape juice allows us to be a truly open Table where anyone is welcome, period. Jesus offered this gift to all, including, in my understanding, children.

So . . . church is over, and there's leftover bread and juice. What happens to these? In the Catholic church, leftover consecrated wine must be consumed by the priest; I don't go that far. My United Methodist tradition, however, has a tradition that the elements be returned to the ground, from whence all life came (Genesis 3:19; Ecclesiastes 3:20). This means, out of respect for the holy nature of the sharing of Communion, we don't simply dispose of the leftovers in the trash. My personal custom is to take the loaf outside and break it up for the birds; the grape juice is poured into the ground.

God gave us a brain to think, a curious mind to question. If there is something we do that you're not sure about, please ask! (We may end up learning the answer together!)

LENTEN STUDY


