Extravagant welcome!

A group of us were recently discussing what it means to be welcoming. The conversation started after we read an article from the Living Waters Association General Minister, Nayiri Karjian.

As is so often the case, as we talked, it became clear that words matter. For instance, when someone joins us for worship for the first time, are they visitors—or guests?

Visitors are often just checking things out. They may tend to be observers, or window-shoppers. Do we have visitors? Sure.

But we also have *guests*. A guest is someone who is invited to visit and participate in an activity, whether they realize it or not. You are so good at making a visitor feel like a guest, that we really don't have very many folks who leave still feeling like "just a visitor."

I am regularly amazed (and delighted) at how easily you make folks feel right at home. It's largely the presence of God's Holy Spirit—but if you weren't so willing to allow the Spirit to move in your hearts, there would be a lot fewer folks saying things like, "When I walked in, I just felt like I was home." And there's always room for more. (Scoot over.)

This, friends, is how Christ welcomes all of us. Writer Anne Lamott puts it this way: I do not at all understand the mystery of grace—only that it meets us where we are, but does not leave us where it found us. At Strongsville UCC, we are getting pretty good at offering this same grace that we have received, to every guest who walks through the door.

For that—and for you—I am grateful. Thank you for being the welcoming hands, feet, and heart of Jesus.





For those of you who have been asking about offering envelopes, our Financial Secretary, Mike Elkins has received a communication from Church Budget, the

company that sends out our envelopes: "Greetings from The Church-Budget Envelope and Mailing Company, Some of you may be aware of delays in the offering envelope mailings over the past couple months. Due to supply chain and the inability to add employees at the rate necessary has created a slow draw on production and shipping. Recently, both of those issues have been resolved. However the "catch-up" would jeopardize long term delivery. In order to get back to expected levels of timely deliveries, we are forced to suspend the production of the remaining supply of your January envelopes. The offering envelopes will resume and be delivered by the first Sunday in March. Quarterly supply will restart in April. Never in our company's history have we had to skip scheduled mailings and we are doing all we can to make sure this never happens again. We deeply apologize for this necessary course of action and the inconveniences this has caused you and your church family.

Please know that you may use any envelope to give your offering--we still need your donations to maintain our ministries! Mike is looking into obtaining loose envelopes to tide us over until March. Please check with him for updates.
