FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

There is no greater love than this. There is no greater gift that can ever be given: To be willing to die that another might live. There is no greater love than this. --Steven Curtis Chapman

True Love.

Did you notice? This year, Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine's Day. It might seem a bit incongruous at first, to be entering the somber Lenten journey on a day we traditionally shower extra love on one another. I'd like to suggest why this is a perfect connection.

As we begin the journey once more from the cradle to the Cross, we can be tempted to fall back on the language of sacrifice, how God sacrificed his son so the rest of us could spend eternity with God. I struggle to imagine, however, a god who would create any beings, simply so they could be sacrificed to appease that god's wrath. The Loving God I know through Jesus doesn't work that way. Our Loving God wants all God's children to live together in love, in this life and the next. As the apostle Paul puts it, In Christ's family there can be no division into Jew and non-Jew, slave and free, male and female. Among us you are all equal. That is, we are all in a common relationship with Jesus Christ. (Galatians 3:28, The Message)

Jesus was sacrificed on the Cross because he called out the Roman authorities for their injustices. He spoke up when the church leaders didn't and for that, he was crucified at the very human hands of the leaders of the day.

Because of Jesus' willingness to do the right thing, we all gained the freedom to live better lives. And because we are now the hands and feet of Jesus, we are called to speak loudly against injustice, to love mercy for all people, and to walk humbly as Jesus walked: alongside the poor, the unwelcomed, the misfits. While we may certainly be destined for eternity, in this lifetime we are called to bring a little more heaven into the life of each person we meet, every day. Ready? Go!




