Through such a simple concept, he has changed thousands of lives., even through devastating circumstances including a fire that completely destroyed all he had worked toward. Today, he is back stronger than ever—because he promised his father he would.

We are stepping out in Hope, into a brand new year. Empty pages on a calendar, filled with promise. What are you hoping to do in 2026? Need help holding your feet to the fire? You are never, ever alone. God promised that in Christ Jesus Emmanuel, *God is with us*. Happy New Year! See you soon!


MARRIAGE CONGRATULATIONS


MISSION OUTREACH NEWS:
