From the Pastor's Desk

So I am asking you not to forget your offering to the church this summer. If possible, I am asking you to make a second-mile love gift for the operation of the church during this season. While I don't know the exact amount, I believe that a second-mile offering totaling around \$4,000 will help carry us through the summer. 
