FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Out of the depths I cry to you, LORD; Lord, hear my voice! I wait for the LORD, my whole being waits, and in his word I put my hope. I wait for the Lord more than watchmen wait for the morning.

Rough nights.

When I was around 9 or 10 years old, our summer vacation took us to Hovenweep National Monument. Hovenweep sits in the Four Corners area, with tentacles in both Colorado and Utah. The monument celebrates the history of over twenty-five ancient peoples who dwelt in this hot, dry land, over 10,000 years ago. It's unlike anywhere else.

There is a *very* primitive campground there, and we had our tent to pitch. Problem was, the ground was so hard and so dry, Dad couldn't drive the stakes in as well as he would have liked. So he set the tent up, and we unrolled the sleeping bags, crawled in and used our body weight to hold it down.

Then the winds came. . . .

We survived, obviously. But even while we *knew*, at some level, that God hadn't deserted us, like Elijah, we realized God's power wasn't in the earthquake, the lightning or the powerful winds. It was in the quiet that settled *after* the storm that God's returning Presence was most strongly felt.

It was a long, scary night, but joy did, indeed, come in the morning.

And it always does, and God always sustains us. Thanks be to God!


