TRANSITION TEAM MEETINGS - STRONGSVILLE UCC - 2017

The first step in the process of transitioning to a new pastor is meeting with the Transition Team to help the Team prepare and define our profile for the Pastoral Search Committee. This team of 6 members (Kelly Bickley, Lloyd Bridle, Ginny Churnega, Tom Gaumer, Cathy Hawk, and Lora Rung) is charged with the following task and purpose:

- 1. To assess and report the culture, dynamics, and ethos of the congregation at this point in time (strengths, weaknesses, how decisions are made and implemented, how various people fit into the structure, etc.).
- 2. To discern and report the hopes and desires of the congregation regarding its vision and mission as it moves forward through this time of transition into the future.
- 3. To allow the congregation to know that there is a plan of transition in place, that qualified and capable people are carrying it out, and that with God's help and guidance we will move together through this time and come out okay on the other side.

Several meetings are being held with all groups in the church and also general congregational gatherings. The general congregational gatherings are for any members not attending a group or committee gathering. They are being held at the church and are scheduled for next Sunday, 3/19, at 11:30 a.m. and Monday, 3/20, at 11:00 a.m. You only need to attend one session.

The following are the questions that are being asked to help the discussions arrive at the input the Transition Team needs:

- 1. In your life at Strongsville UCC, what has been the most meaningful to you?
- 2. In your life at Strongsville UCC, has there been anything that has caused you discomfort or stress, and if so, what?
- 3. What keeps you coming back?
- 4. What do you understand is our mission and how might we better accomplish it?
- 5. What would the community lack if we closed our doors?
- 6. Is there an identifiable demographic in our community with whom we are not involved, or could be involved with more?
- 7. Is there anything we're doing that you wish we weren't?
- 8. Is there anything we're not doing that you wish we were?
