The first step in the process of transitioning to a new pastor is meeting with the Transition Team to help the Team prepare and define our profile for the Pastoral Search Committee. This team of 6 members (Kelly Bickley, Lloyd Bridle, Ginny Churnega, Tom Gaumer, Cathy Hawk, and Lora Rung) is charged with the following task and purpose:

1. To assess and report the culture, dynamics, and ethos of the congregation at this point in time (strengths, weaknesses, how decisions are made and implemented, how various people fit into the structure, etc.). 2. To discern and report the hopes and desires of the congregation regarding its vision and mission as it moves forward through this time of transition into the future. 3. To allow the congregation to know that there is a plan of transition in place, that qualified and capable people are carrying it out, and that with God's help and guidance we will move together through this time and come

out okay on the other side. Several meetings are being held with all groups in the church and also general congregational gatherings. The general congregational gatherings are for any members not attending a group or committee gathering. They are being held at the church and are scheduled for TODAY, 3/19, at 11:30 a.m. and tomorrow—Monday, 3/20—at 11:00 a.m. You only need to attend one session.
