FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

God is a God of the present. God is always in the moment, be that moment hard or easy, joyful and painful.

God Happens. (And other stuff, too!)

Wow. Virtual worship has been a really interesting experience for all of us, hasn't it? We are learning as we go, about camera angles and sound pickup (if it's the same microphone, why does the sound pick up better in the pulpit than on the floor???); about recording and transitioning, about camera angles. The pastor's wife is becoming a very skilled videographer, and the pastor is especially grateful to him, as well as Doug Thorn, who volunteer their time when we gather to worship (virtually) every week.

It's hard work. And sometimes, it's less than perfect. Odd sounds are picked up by the camera mic. Wrong hymns are announced. Words are stumbled over. Emergency vehicles scream past during silent prayer.

Sometimes, we back up and give ourselves a do-over. But on Sunday mornings, I don't get a do-over. As in Life, on Sunday mornings, I laugh, correct the course and try not to beat myself up over whatever goes awry. Because in worship, I believe, even when "stuff" happens, *God* happens, too.

For many people who may have been burned by a church, online worship has become a safe portal for reentry. This time of pandemic may leave some folks anxious, wondering about a Supreme Being, by whatever name we choose to call God. On YouTube, they can peek around the corner, see what we are about. They can see that we love one another, a *lot*, and we are just ordinary people seeking time with one another and with the Almighty.

At the end of the day, I have no doubt in my heart that God has been glorified in our worship. God doesn't expect perfection. God expects us to show up and bring it: bring the joy and the love, as well as the brokenness and frustration.

I believe God celebrates our efforts, our *desire* to bring God our very best (even when we fall short). Stuff happens. (The Greek word for that is *skubalon*.) Whatever happens in life, God manages to turn it for good. And for that, I am forever grateful. (For *you*, I am forever grateful.)

As my mother would say . . . now go wash those little handy pandies!

 - Tyler Martin, student at University of Cincinnati, whose wonderful tenor voice added so much to our Palm Sunday service;
 - Cindy Smith, whose smooth vocals added so much to our recent services.
- Without volunteers Doug Thorn, Jim Heinrich and Chuck McDougall, the

- services would never leave the building. Doug manages the sound board, while Chuck is our newest videographer. By Sunday morning, somehow, through the marvels of modern technology, all this comes together every week and shows up on our YouTube channel and our website.
- ▼ Then comes the (second) most important element of our worship experience: YOU. You show up, in your Sunday Best or your jammies, maybe with coffee in hand, and you join us. You pray with us and for us. You sing, I hope, and listen, and learn. You allow God's Holy Spirit (the most important element) to work in your heart and in your life. 


CHURCH OFFICE

A LETTER FROM THE HEARTLAND CONFERENCE OF THE UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST

Recommendations to Pastors and Churches Regarding In-Person Worship in May

Dear Friends in Christ,

The season of the COVID 19 pandemic continues to lengthen testing our patience in many ways. There is a palpable, eager longing to gather and return to a sense of what is familiar. Especially there is a yearning to gather in person for worship. We certainly share this desire and also carry a deep concern for everyone's health and safety. Because of this, we write to offer our strong recommendation that congregations not gather for worship at least until May 31st and possibly beyond. We recognize that each congregation has the authority to make its own decisions in this matter but there are several concerns we feel are deeply worthy of your consideration.

First, there still remains the restriction from the Ohio Department of Health regarding large group gatherings and the importance of the continued practice of physical, social distancing. While the COVID 19 curve has been flattened, the potency of the virus remains. Those over age 65 and those with respiratory and autoimmune health issues are still at higher risk, even as we know that COVID 19 has claimed the lives of those much younger and those with no apparent prior health challenges.

Second, the re-engagement of in-person worship will require special planning and protocols that will be necessary to keep our gathered congregations safe. It will be vitally important to have these protocols well developed and well communicated in order to do our part to help prevent a resurgence that would again cause the need for sheltering at home. Now is the time to begin thinking carefully about the guidelines you will follow when the time to meet in person comes.

These weeks and months have been challenging indeed. We are so thankful for your leadership and care. We know this time has required new ways of engaging ministry at practically every level. As always, we hold you in our prayers and are glad to

be available as you consider the next phases of church life and the possibilities of re-gathering.
