# OUTREACH OPPORTUNITY IN CELEBRATION OF 200<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY

Through November 19, we are collecting small Christmas gifts for adults who use the Food Bank. Please use the cloth or paper bags by the Christmas wrapped box in the Gathering Area to provide new gift items not exceeding \$5.00 for either a woman or man. Please indicate on the tag whether your gift is for a man or woman. The week of November 20, we will attach a Christmas message and a brief history of our church to each bag. The gifts will then be taken to the Food Bank for distribution in December. If you took a gift bag for this outreach, please return it to the church with your gift by next Sunday, November 19. Thank you!

The Mitten Tree will be in the Gathering Area from November 19 to December 3, 2017, for collecting donations of hats, gloves, mittens and scarves for Brookside Center. Brookside is an ecumenical center that provides clothing and necessities to the poor and needy and is located on Pearl Road in Cleveland.
