PARKING LOT UPDATE

Repair of our church parking lot is scheduled to begin next week. Saw cutting is scheduled for tomorrow-- Monday, November 23, at 7:00 a.m. This is expected to be an all-day event and may possibly go into Tuesday morning as well. Saw cutting is a very dirty job, and the contractor recommends that everyone refrains from parking in the lot during that process. The excavation/remainder of the parking lot work is scheduled to begin Monday, November 30. The parking lot will remain closed throughout this portion of the project. This phase should take 3-4 days to complete. The contractor intends to open the lot to traffic the Sunday following the completion of work. Much of this project is weather-dependent, so the schedule may be adjusted accordingly.
