FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

That time of year again. . . .

It's that time of year again, when churches everywhere begin grappling with stewardship issues (read: budgets and money) and we revisit once more who we are and who we are called to be as Christ's church. My monthly newsletter offering to you, in a sense, becomes a stewardship offering of prayer, to guide us along our path as we seek to draw ever closer to God and to one another. Many are drawn to this place, with the same desire: to draw closer to God.

People might come to Strongsville UCC for the first time because we are near where they live or work, or they saw our beautiful steeple or heard our bells. (A recent visitor told me she and her husband rode by this church on their motorcycle forty-two years ago, and she told him: Someday, we're going to go to church there! Never underestimate the power of a planted seed.) Maybe they heard about our magnificent music; but they will return because they experience the irresistible, winsome love of the Christ moving in our midst. And they like what they experienced. They long for more.

We don't get to "choose" who walks through our doors. God sends whom God sends. Our primary task is to open our hearts, to see the divine image of the Creator in whomever crosses our threshold, and to mean it in our hearts and in our words when we say, "All are welcome here."*
