FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

*But what about you? Who do **you** say that I am?*
—Matthew 16:15

Asking questions

I don't know about you, but it seems like more often than not, I am trying to get an answer when I pray. Something is not making sense, or something needs changing. *Please God—why aren't you hearing my questions?*

We are no different from the disciples in that regard. Whenever Jesus takes them aside, they are asking questions. *What does this parable mean, Jesus? When will you bring down destruction on the evil ones? How are we supposed to feed all these people with a single loaf?*

But if we pay close attention to what Jesus is actually saying and doing, it becomes apparent that he is all about leading the disciples (and us) to find their own answers.

Preacher/ theologian Martin Copenhaver discovered that the gospel records 307 questions asked by Jesus. Some are rhetorical or philosophical: *Which one of you, by worrying, can add a single hour to your life? Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'?* But others are deeply personal: *What do you want me to do for you? Why are you so afraid? Where is your faith?*

On the other hand . . . others ask only 183 questions of Jesus.

It's almost as if Jesus expects us to really stop and *think*, she said with a wink. . . .

One last question: *What are you afraid of?* Trust me: God is big enough to handle any questions you might have. Even the tough ones that seem to have no answers.

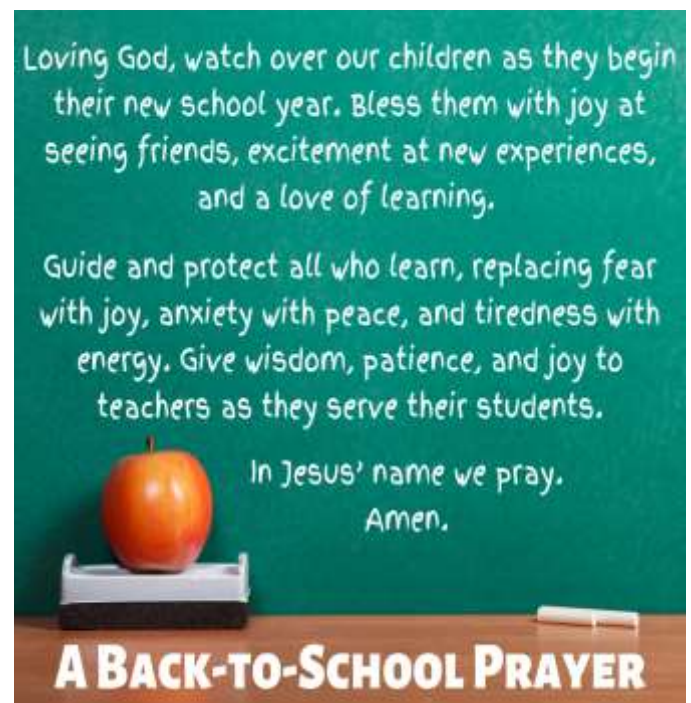
